This innovative unit incorporates the latest in cutting-edge technology, combined with a unique, Montessori-centered approach to individualized care, focused on supporting the person behind the dementia and ensuring the highest quality of daily living suited to each resident's needs.



The Memory Special Care Unit (MSCU) focuses on improving the well-being of individuals with Alzheimer's and other dementing illnesses to support them in meeting the challenges of their late-life stages, by anticipating needs and providing comfort, autonomy, and security.

Putting Special in the Memory Special Care Unit

A Montessori-based approach is incorporated in our activities to help stimulate preserved memory and cognitive skills, such as:

- Chair movement/adapted yoga
- Reading groups
- Mind stretchers
- Creative writing
- Word games
- Musical memories
- Sing along
- Pet visits
- Self-expression through art

The goal for each resident is to participate in activities that are meaningful to them; allowing them to feel useful, apply life-skills, and enhance cognitive stimulation and physical activity.

We ensure that our staff has access to current educational tools and cutting-edge technology to continually advance our care practices – specifically for those with memory loss, including the Montessori for Dementia Training approach on the MSCU.
