## Memory Special Care Unit Opens at Loretto Health & Rehabilitation



With the support of some grant funding from the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation, we successfully opened a **Memory Special Care Unit [MSCU]** at Loretto Health and Rehabilitation on January 2, 2023. In just five months, we renovated an entire floor in the Cunningham building to support the unique needs of those in the most advanced stages of the disease. The new 12th floor unit offers 30 individual rooms for long-term memory care residents.

With a focus on meeting each resident's individual needs based on the complexity of the disease,

Loretto's 12th floor incorporates a new holistic approach. Using an emerging Montessori care philosophy, the environment has been filled with cues and memory supports that enable individuals to care for themselves, others, and their community, providing structure and a greater sense of purpose for the residents living on this floor. Staff completed a detailed training program to prepare the team to incorporate this Montessori-based approach into daily living activities and routines.

## Residents Engage with New Memory Care Technology

It's Never Too Late (iN2L) technology was recently introduced at several Loretto facilities to help provide engaging, resident-centered programming. From dancing to reminiscing, these systems have been a hit!

iN2L uses touch screens to bring customized content to help residents engage, including cognitive games, sensory experiences, guided physical activities, realistic reminiscing videos, music and more.

After receiving a grant from M&T Bank, Loretto was able to implement the iN2L system at several facilities, including The Nottingham, The Commons on St. Anthony, The Heritage, and Loretto Health & Rehabilitation. iN2L has completely changed the level of engagement that therapists can have with dementia care programming.

A favorite feature among many memory care residents is the music programming, which can help to spark a memory and improve moods. iN2L offers sing-alongs, music trivia, dancing and "name that singer," or they can reminisce over catchy commercials and jingles from residents' younger days. Not only might this spark a memory, but it can also create entertaining conversations and interactions among residents and staff.



# A Letter from The President & CEO

2022 was another busy year for our Loretto communities. This year we had many highlights across our organization including: launching our Loretto EDGE programs which enrolled 40 employees in the inaugural class of our leadership training program, over 35 employees in the Alzheimer's essentiALZ training program, and 15 in our ServSafe class. In addition, we fully implemented Point.Click.Care, our electronic medical records system, which allows us to move residents to the right level of care. We also expanded our Restorative Care Unit (RCU), continued to expand our PACE CNY program, and in the beginning of 2023, we opened our NEW Memory Special Care Unit (MSCU).

Our donors again continue to amaze us! Our Annual Appeal raised over **\$230,000** and our Giving Tuesday campaign brought in an additional **\$18,000**. These funds help us continue to meet the needs of our residents, participants, and employees, including our **WeCare Fund** which allowed us to assist employees financially in 2022 with over \$14,069 in emergency hardship grants.

As we enter a new year, we are excited for what lies ahead and the advances we will continue to make throughout our organization as we show our community how we **make every day extraordinary**.






## FirstLight Matches Giving Tuesday Donations
