In September 2024, the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) announced a data breach which had compromised the data of some of their participants. If your information was compromised you received a letter directly from CMS making you aware.

From the CMS Website:

At this time, we are not aware of any reports of identity fraud or improper use of your information as a direct result of this incident.

However, if your MBI was potentially affected, a new Medicare card with a new number will be issued to you. CMS will mail the new card to your address in the coming weeks. In the meantime, you can continue to use your existing Medicare card.

If you get a new card, you should:

- a. Follow the instructions in the letter that comes with your new card.
- b. Destroy your old Medicare card.
- c. Inform your providers that you have a new Medicare Number.

If you receive a new Medicare Card please provide this information to The Nottingham to update your Resident Records.


