On-Site Dialysis Services

Loretto Health and Rehabilitation now offers on-site hemodialysis services for short-term rehabilitation residents.

Our program offers two-to-three-hour sessions five times per week, compared to three longer off-site sessions, reducing complications such as cardiovascular, electrolyte, and fluid imbalances, and enhancing residents' quality of life.
